



To help you select a tour best suited to your riding comfort and skill, we included the terrain you will most likely encounter on selected tour.

The grade code is from 1 to 10 with one being the easiest to ride and manoeuvre and 10 being most challenging to ride due to obstacles, slopes, terrain roughness.

Grade:

1 – trail, pathway, residential streets, slopes

2 – trails, pathways, residential streets, roadways, slopes

3 – terrain trails, pathways, roadways, highway w/shoulders, hills/valleys

3 pro – terrain trails, pathways, roadways, highway w/without shoulders, steel hills/valleys

4 – forest trails, wide track

5 – forest trails, wide track, waterways (may go over streams or shallow water)

6 – forest trails, wide/single track, waterways

7 – forest trails, wide/single tracks, waterways, logs/stones

8 – forest trails, wide/single tracks, waterways, logs/stones, terrain trails, pathways, roadways, highways w/shoulders, hills/valleys, boardwalks

9 - forest trails, wide/single tracks, waterways, logs/stones, narrow crossings, pathways, roadways, highways w/shoulders, hills/valleys, boardwalks, jumps

10 - forest trails, wide/single tracks, waterways, logs/stones, narrow crossings, pathways, roadways, highways w/shoulders, declines/inclines, jumps

10 pro - forest trails, wide/single tracks, waterways, logs/stones, narrow crossings, pathways, roadways, highways w/shoulders, declines/inclines, jumps/ramps

10 extreme – washaway sand, boulders/rocks, wide/single tracks, logs/stones, narrow crossings, pathways, roadways, highways w/shoulder, declines/inclines
